Moving Day: Abraham

Week Three

Memory Verse: “Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.”

Hebrews 11:1

Challenge Verse: “Know therefore that the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations,” Deuteronomy 7:9

Genesis 12 teaches us that God is always in control!

Day 1 - Read Hebrews 11:8-10 How did Abraham show that he trusted God’s plan? What was Abraham looking forward to by faith?

Day 2 - Read Genesis 12:1-9 Work together as a family to draw a mural (like a travel map) of Abraham’s travels. Look online at a Bible map to see the distances that God led Abraham.

Day 3 - Read Genesis 12:1-9 Discuss the promises that God made to Abraham in verses 2-3. Look at Matthew 1:1-16 to see how God fulfilled His promise to bless all peoples of the earth through Abraham. Who does this promise point to?

Day 4 - Read Romans 4:13 Work together as a family to make up motions to help you learn this verse. Discuss the meaning of this verse.

Day 5 - Read Romans 4 This is a really complicated chapter, but it reminds us of an amazing truth...that salvation is by faith alone. Discuss how that truth is shown in this chapter. Then, look up Ephesians 2:8-9. According to those verses (& Romans 4:2), what would happen if we could be justified through the law?

Open your Bible to the book whose name is hidden in this sentence:

“use your marker to write”

The chapter you are looking for is the number of commandments that God gave Moses. The verse is the chapter number times 2 minus 2.

FROM HERE TO THERE #2

Open your Bible to the book with a person's name that has a story about lions.

The chapter number is the number of days in which God created the world plus 3. And the verse number is the same as the chapter number.

Verse is

FROM HERE TO THERE #3

Open your Bible to first book in the Bible with a girls' name.
Then turn 3 books to the left.

The chapter number you're looking for is the number of Jesus' disciples times 3 minus 4. The verse number is the number of Jesus' disciples divided by 3.

FROM HERE TO THERE #4

Open to the 3rd Gospel, turn 3 books to the left.

The chapter you are looking for is a number that's already been mentioned twice.

The verse number is the chapter number times 3 minus 3.

Verse is

FROM HERE TO THERE #5

Open to the first of the 3 books with the same name.

Find the chapter that's the same numbers as the day on which God created birds & fish (check Genesis 1:20-23).

The verse is the chapter number plus the chapter number

FROM HERE TO THERE #6

Open to the last chapter of the longest book in the Bible.

Divide the total number of chapters by 3 and open to that chapter. Move 3 chapters to the left to find your chapter.

The verse is the day on which Isaac was circumcised (Genesis 21:4).
