Rock-a-Bye Baby: Moses

Week Four

Memory Verse: “Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.”
Hebrews 11:1

Challenge Verse: “For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.” Ephesians 2:8-9

Exodus 1-2 teach us that God is a refuge for His people.

Day 1 - Read Exodus 1 What has happened to the people since Joseph died? Play with play dough while retelling this portion of the story to remember that God’s people were working as slaves building things in Egypt.

Day 2 - Read Exodus 2:1-10 How was God a Deliverer to Moses? Who did God use to rescue Moses? How does this show us God’s sovereign plan?

Day 3 - Read Exodus 2:11-15 How did it make Moses feel to see his family (God’s people) being oppressed? Why did Moses run away?

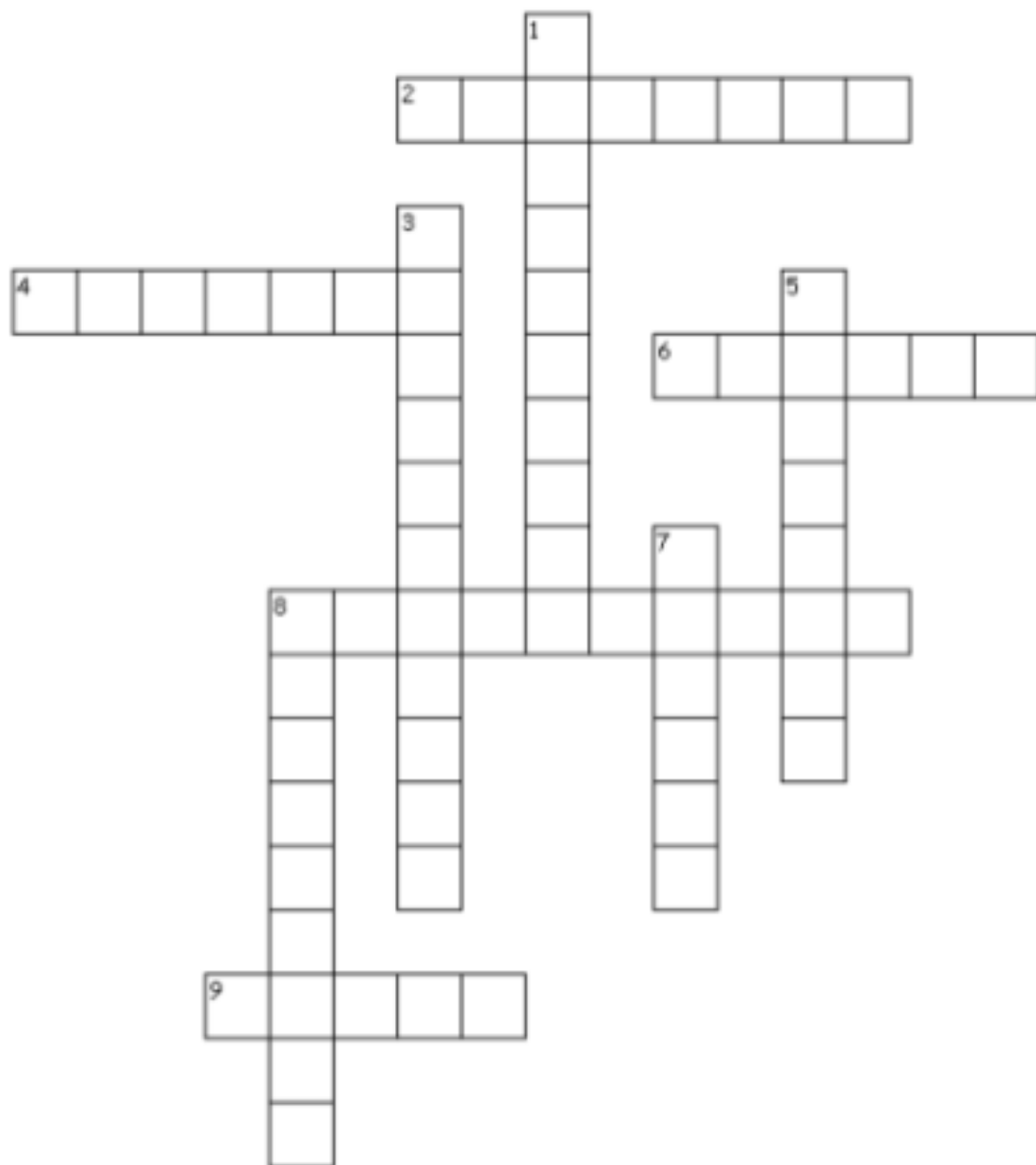
Day 4 - Read 2 Samuel 22 Make a list of all the things you learn about God in this passage. Did you hear anything about God as a refuge for His people? Write that verse (verse 2) in the shape of a cross as a reminder that the ultimate way that God delivered His people was through Jesus’ death on the cross in our place.

Day 5 - Read Colossians 3:1-17 Saying that God is our refuge has the idea of being hidden in or Him. What do these verses say about being hidden with God? According to these verses what should the person who is hidden with Christ’s (a believer/ a follower of Jesus) life look like compared to the world?

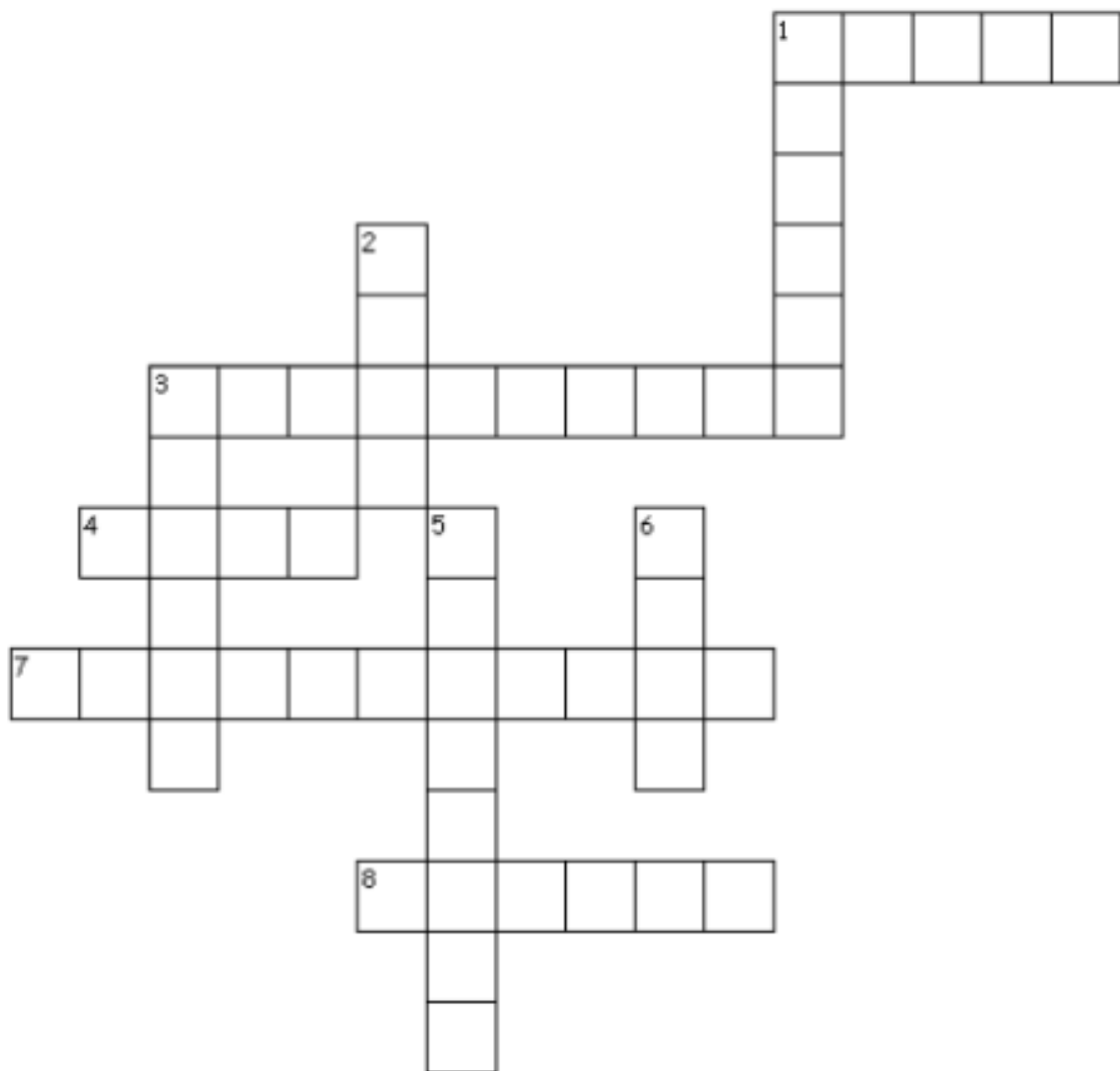
