

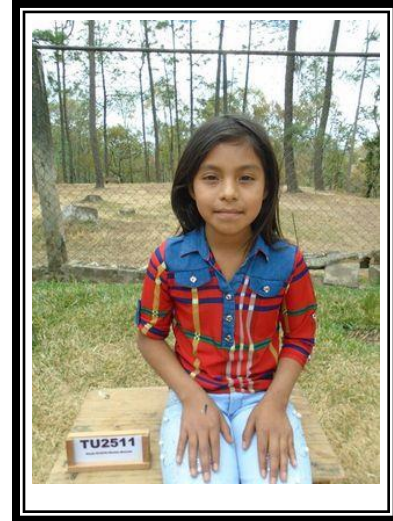
# LIVING WATER ADOPT-A-CHILD

He is in the United States but is in touch with us and sends us economic support. My family and I are members of Prince of Peace Church. I want to ask for your prayers for my mother's health because she suffers from headaches and gastritis. Fortunately she has already visited the doctor and is under medical treatment. I suffer from stomachaches and my mother gives me some medicines. Besides that the rest of my family is in good health. We received the visit of LW staff and they pray with us and encouraged us to go ahead and always trusting in our Lord. In spite of the hard health situation that we are currently facing in our country, our Lord has been taking care of us. We are praying for your family and for all the world. We trust in our Lord's mercy and that He will put His healing hands over all people who are suffering during this pandemic.
